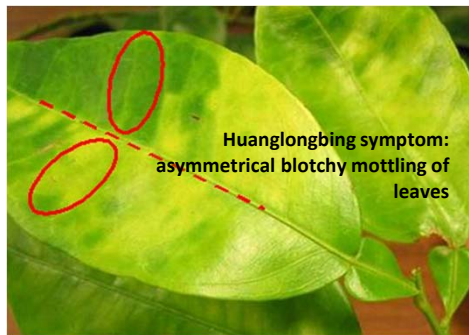
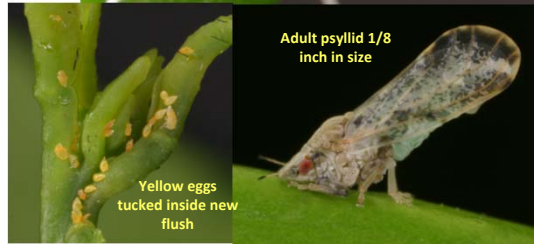


**Asian Citrus Psyllid**  
*Diaphorina citri* is an insect vector of Huanglongbing disease of citrus. Psyllid feeding damage includes twisting and burned tips of new flush.

**Huanglongbing or citrus greening disease** is caused by a bacterium. Symptoms of the disease include leaf mottling, yellow shoots, twig dieback and small hard fruit with a bitter taste. There is no cure for the disease, which is spread by the psyllid or by grafting infected budwood.
